Auditions: Sunday 8 November at 16:30, Theatr Brycheiniog Studio

Brecon Festival Ballet returns to Theatr Brycheiniog this Christmas with five performances of The Nutcracker, the production that first sold out to enthusiastic audiences in 2019 and continues to sell out every year since!

The Snowflakes Chorus sings with Brecon Festival Ballet Orchestra in Act I. Singers sit in the side stalls and so get to see the ballet for free as well as being part of the performance.

If you would like to audition, we are looking for 5-7 sopranos and 5-7 altos. At the audition you will be taught part of the Nutcracker score and will sing as a group.
